◆Types of Entrance Examinations

There are two types of entrance exams for the university and junior college.

POINT① The exam is only an **interview**.

POINT② There are scholarships to reduce tuition. If your Japanese is good, the entrance fee may also be reduced.

Types of Entrance Exams	Application Eligibility	Exam Method
General (interview on campus)	To apply for <u>the Faculty of Human and Social Studies (University)</u> or <u>the Department of Contemporary Communication (Junior College)</u> , international students must have taken one of the following tests: ① EJU (Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students) ② JLPT (Japanese Language Proficiency Test) ③ J.TEST (Test of Practical Japanese) ④ JPT (Japanese Proficiency Test)	In person (on campus)
General Online (interview online)	To apply for <u>the Department of Food and Nutrition (Junior College)</u> , international students must meet both of the following conditions: ① Have a combined score of 200 points or more in the Listening, Listening-Reading, and Reading sections on the EJU ② Have taken the Science section (either Biology or Chemistry) on the EJU.	Online (Zoom)

◆Tuition Reduction Scholarship System for International Students

- ▶ This is called the **Tuition Reduction System for Privately-Financed International Students**.
- ▶ With this system, **your tuition can be reduced by one-third**.

※Only students who meet certain conditions regarding their part-time job, financial support, and grades can qualify.

▶ **If your Japanese is good, your entrance fee will be even cheaper!**

When submitting your application documents to the university, you can get a **¥40,000 discount on the entrance fee** if you meet **one** of the following:

- Passed JLPT **N2**
- Scored **200 points or more** in the Japanese section of the EJU

◆International Student Center Support for Student Life
